NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The races and series will be governed by the 2009-2012 I.S.A.F. Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions and special regulations of the A.Y.F., the constitution of the Cleveland Yacht Club Inc., the class rules of the respective classes except as any of these are altered by these Sailing Instructions.

Racing rule(s) will be changed as follows:

RRS Rule 35: The time limit for the lead boat shall be 1500 hrs for all classes. Subsequent boats that do not cross the finish line before 1600 hrs will be scored as Did Not Finish (DNF). This changes RRS Rule 35.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The race is open to

Trailable dinghies or catamarans with a yardstick defined by the Victorian Yachting Council
Trailable yachts; The Trailable Yacht Conversion Factor will be used

Yachts will be rated using data from the CYC JAM Session and RQ Wags races.

Yachts may nominate to use a spinnaker.

Classes without a rating may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and presenting it upon signing on to the race

Yachts may enter by radio to the Race Committee on Channel 11 or at the Icon Bar, Raby Bay from 8:30 – 9:30am

3. FEES

The entry fee will be \$35 for boats of 2 or more persons.

\$25 for single handed boats.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available no later than 0900 on the day of the race. Yachts will be given instructions via VHF channel 11.

6. VENUE

Cleveland Yacht Club; Racing will be around Peel Island

7. THE COURSES

The course will be a passage race round peel Island as detailed in the sailing instructions.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

Penalty turns as per Rule 44.1

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 boats in each race division with 5 or more entries.
