Race Administration

In conjunction with the Sailing Committee the Race Office<u>r</u> (RO) is responsible for both the general running of the club and the sailing on their rostered day.

Fees

On all club sailing days, a fee of \$15 per boat is charged to cover the club operating costs, such as fuel for the safety boats. This fee is payable for racing or social sailing days.

A fee of \$20 will apply to all visitors.

Rules and Liability

The races shall be governed by the International Sailing Federation 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) with the prescriptions and special regulations of Australian Sailing and the applicable Sailing Instructions for the event. Sailing Instructions for Club events are available on the Club's website.

All boats taking part in any race do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Cleveland Yacht Club, including their committee, officials and sponsors accept no responsibility for the seaworthiness of any boat whose entry is accepted, or for the sufficiency or adequacy of its equipment.

Attention is drawn to Fundamental Rule 4 of the RRS which states:

"A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing."

The Sailing Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry to any race.

Divisions

Club events will be split into Catamaran and Monohull. In the sailing program SC indicates short course racing. TROPHIES are awards only awarded to FINANCIAL MEMBERS.

Protest Committee

The Protest committee will comprise of one member from each division as well as one of the following: member of the Sailing Committee, Vice Commodore, or Commodore

PLEASE NOTE

Cleveland Yacht Club **DOES NOT ALLOW SAILING** from the club premises if there is a **STRONG WIND WARING** current for Moreton Bay.

Notification of Non-Sailing will be given on the website by 8am on the day of the race, go to www.cyc.asn.au if in doubt.

In Addition

An average wind strength cut off of 22 Knots will be used to determine if sailing will occur, or at the discretion of the Race Officer or Sailing Committee.

Insurance

Compulsory Third Party (CTP) racing coverage insurance **MUST BE HELD** by a boat to be eligible to compete.

Race Management Team

All club members are required to participate in duties of the Race Management Team (RMT).

Duty Roster

Members who have a family membership are required to nominate a second person for the duty roster.

The rostered Race Officer (RO) is highlighted in **Bold** in the Calendar.

Race Management Team duties are outlined on the club notice board. Five members will be required to cover the duty roster. Duties include operating the safety boats, setting up and operating the canteen until the briefing has finished, ramp assistance and to be responsible for running the timing box. It is a requirement that two duty delegates will clean and close the clubhouse at the end of the days sailing.

All members rostered on duty are credited with entering races sailed on that day but **must** record their names on the sign on/off sheet.

If you are unable to do your rostered day, please notify the RO and arrange a swap with another member.

If you need to initiate a swap with another member, allow yourself plenty of time to do so.

Please notify the Sailing Committee with the details of any changes arranged.

As a very last resort, contact a member of the Sailing Committee to help you organize a swap with another member.

Members failing to fulfil their duties and/or choosing to sail on their rostered day will receive a Non-Excludable Disqualification for those race/races.

Club Races and Series Results

Races will be handicapped, and series will be scored as set out in the table opposite.

<u>Club Championship</u> will be determined using the results from ALL club championship races as indicated in the club calendar. Club Championship will be scored using ASY. The Club championship results may discard 25% of results for club races (excluding cancelled races). 50% of the races completed in the two series (Spring & Autumn) must be sailed to be eligible for the Club Championship.

Spring Club Championship will be determined using the results of those races identified as Club Championship completed prior to Christmas. Spring Club Championship will be scored using ASY. The Spring Club championship results may discard 25% of results for club races (excluding cancelled races). 50% of completed races must be sailed to be eligible for the Spring Club Championship.

Autumn Club Championship will be determined using the results of those race completed after Christmas. Autumn Club Championship will be scored using ASY. The Autumn Club championship results may discard 25% of results for club races (excluding cancelled races). 50% of completed races in the series must be sailed to be eligible for the Autumn Club Championship.

Notes: Number of races to be sailed to be eligible for a series result and the number of races that may be discard are rounded down to a whole race after calculation with the percentage. ASY is the Australian Sailing Yardstick handicap rating system [The ASY is allocated to the class of boat]. HC is personal Handicap factor. [Handicaps follow a boat/skipper combination]
